

Horse riding has had to deal with a lot of bad press due to animal activists. This created a bad image that is not the truth.


We aim for a symbiose relationship with our horses.

Physical and mental health benefits

Physical fitness and body awareness

For good communication with your horse you have to be aware of and be able to control your own body. A rider can not sit still just by sitting still; sitting on a horse without disturbing the movements is not easy!

Mental benefits

Being in nature with horses can reduce stress levels, allowing you to relax and unwind in a natural environment. The bond between horse and human is something beautiful and special. The communication is without words, and therefore very pure. Horses teach you self reflection and help you to learn more about yourself. Horse people often call their horses their therapist or mental coach.

Connection with nature

Many people nowadays live a life where they are disconnected from nature. Horses fosters a deeper connection with nature. On horseback you can reach beautiful places that you would not find by car or by foot.

- inspirować się w stylu oznak Dzikiego lasu / Wielkopolski Park Narodowy / Parku Miejskiego...
 - miejsca popularne to m.in. trasy, przystanki, punkty widokowe, ogrody zdrojowe
 - nazwy oznak - tabliczki - tablice informacyjne (5 cm) / przestrzeni (prędkości, wiatra, WODA, trawa)
 - 10 - 20 cm miejsca postojowe
 - kolorystyczne = istniejący infrastruktury stojące -
- wyrażenie opartego na zasadach projektowania
- problem zapoznawania się z lasami, itd
- sporządzanie regulaminów użytkowania infrastruktury
- zwierzę chodzące do nowego problemu
- operator szlaku, akcje, informacje m.in. informacje na temat zwierząt wokół szlaków / parków
